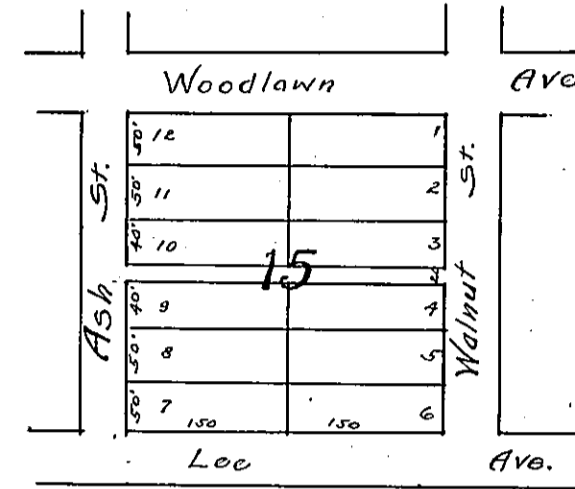


— Re-Plat of Block 15, Pulaski Heights. —

Know all men by these presents:

That, whereas, the Pulaski Heights Land Company, being the owner of Block 15 and other blocks in Pulaski Heights; in filing the plat of said Block 15, it provided for an alley in said block, 20 feet wide, running North and South through the center of said block, and that shortly afterwards it was deemed advisable to re-plot the said block, closing the alley running North and South, which alley had in fact never been opened and never had been used as an alley, and that a new alley would be opened running through the center of said block from East to West, and

Whereas, the said new plat was never filed for record, Now, Therefore, That the said alley running North and South in said block may be closed under the authority and provisions contained in the bill of assurance heretofore filed for record, wherein the said block was platted, we, the said Pulaski Heights Land Company, Carrie L. Auten, C. N. Faubel and F. H. Fulkerson, owners of the property in said block, have caused a new plat of said block to be made as follows:



And we hereby agree with each other and the public, that the said alley running North and South through the said block, as heretofore platted, shall be closed, and the and the ground shown therein shall attach to and become a part of the lots adjoining, making each lot in said block 150 ft. East and West instead of 140 ft. as shown in said plat; and further, we hereby open and dedicate to the public an alley 20 ft. wide running East and West, as shown in the plat hereto attached, the said alley to remain open for a public easement subject to the reservations only as mentioned in the former bill of assurance wherein the said block was platted, as shown by the records in Pulaski County, and that hereafter the lots in the said block shall be of the number and of the size and dimension as shown on the plat hereto attached.
